

SHIPPER BEST PRACTICES

FOR DRIVER CHECK-IN



ASK THE CARRIER

**...WHO THEY WORK FOR.
CONFIRM THIS MATCHES THE
SIDE OF THE TRACTOR.**

Do not accept a tractor with temporary identifiers (taped/posterboard/paper, etc. over MC/DOT number.)

**...IF THEY BOOKED THE LOAD
THROUGH A BROKER AND
WHO IT WAS. CONFIRM THIS
MATCHES WHAT IS EXPECTED.**

**...WHERE THE LOAD IS
DELIVERING. CONFIRM THIS
MATCHES WHAT IS EXPECTED.**



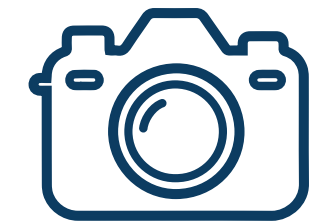
**SCAN THE DRIVER'S ID. IF NOT
POSSIBLE, TAKE A PHOTO.**

Ensure the ID photo matches the individual picking up the load.



**BEFORE APPLYING THE SEAL,
MAKE SURE BOLT AND
DOORS HAVE NOT BEEN
TAMPERED WITH.**

If bolt threads are pointed out, that's an indication the door can be opened without removing the seal.



**TAKE PHOTOS/VIDEO
FOOTAGE OF THE TRACTOR
AND TRAILER.**

Document your load as a safety precaution.



IF CARGO GOES MISSING:

- Contact your local police precinct and the broker on the load.
- Supply all above documented information to law enforcement and the broker.
