Disaster Recovery

Hurricane season is June-November.

Be cautious of shipments containing relief supplies and building materials destined for impacted areas. They are frequent targets of opportunistic and strategic theft.

Redirected Shipments

Bad actors are impersonating brokers and shippers, instructing drivers to deliver to unauthorized locations. Mitigate risk by advising drivers to only deliver to the address on the BOL.

Enhance Driver Check-in Process

Obtain driver, carrier and equipment information prior to loading. If any details do not exactly match the expected documentation, do not load and contact your LAE. Document all available information.

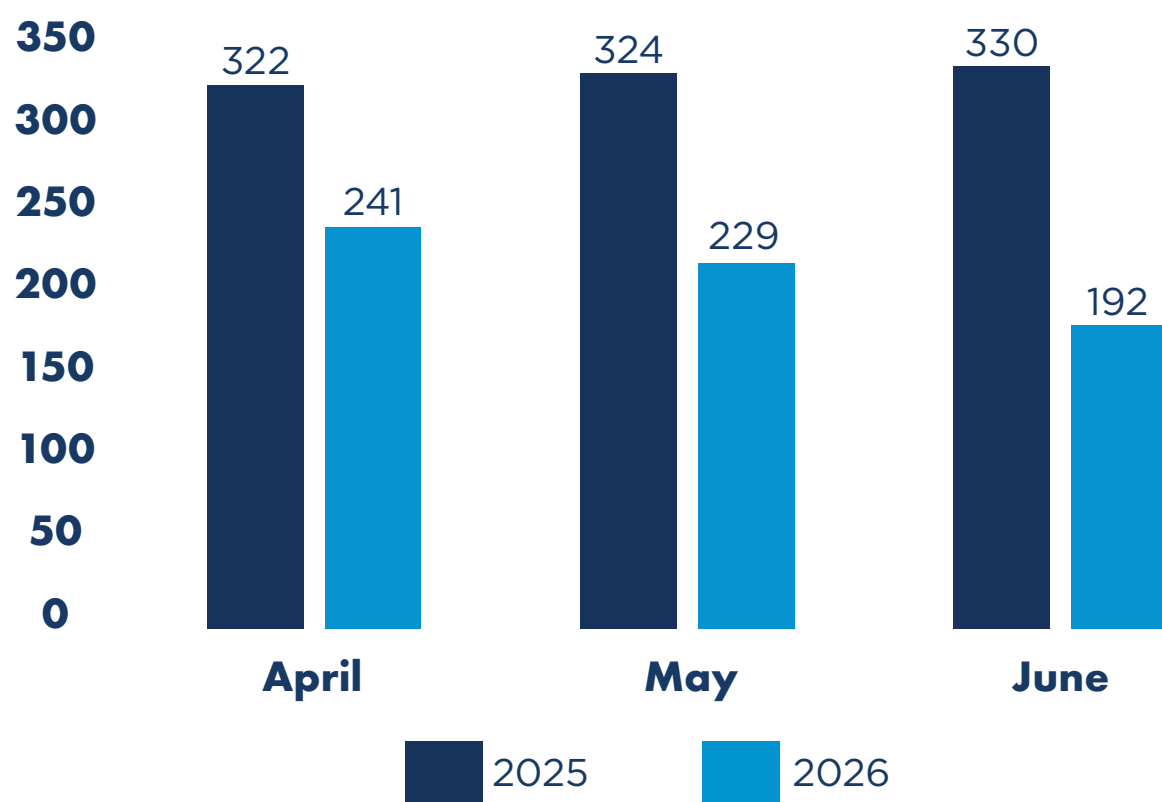

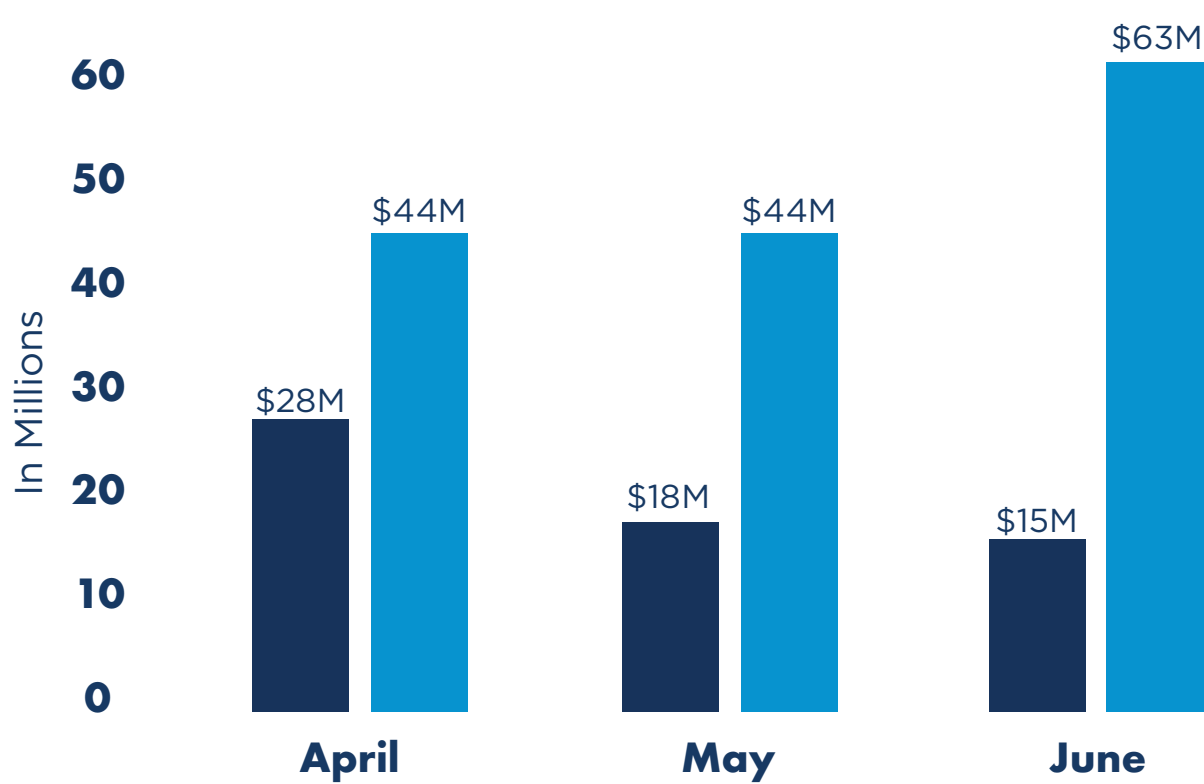

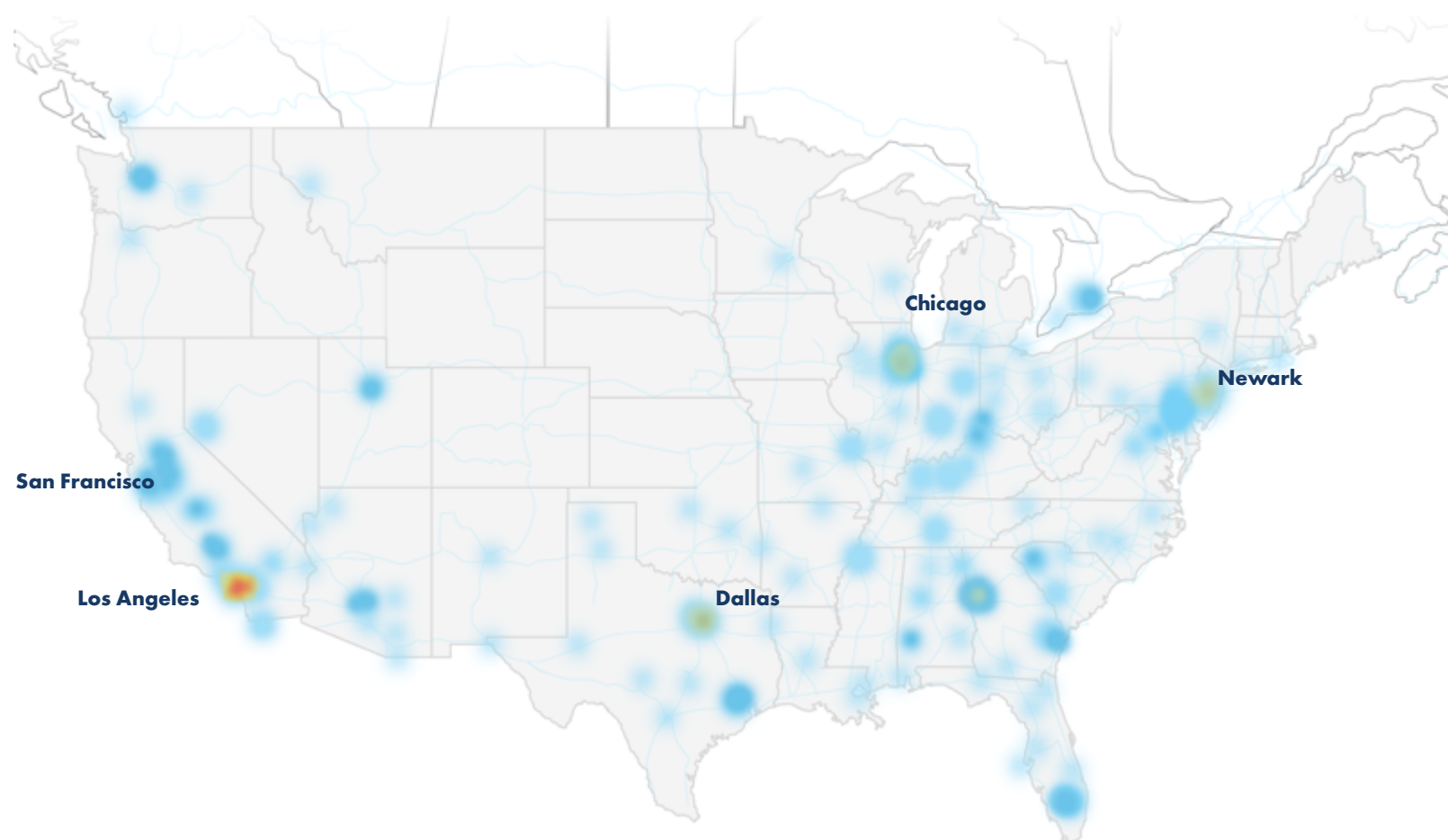
INDUSTRYWIDE INCIDENTS REPORTED¹
